Dear Minister,

I understand that the government has decided not to maintain the current UK requirement for an annual MOT test after a vehicle is four years old. I appreciate that EU legislation establishes a minimum requirement for vehicles to be tested every two years but, as you will be aware, this can be improved upon by member states.

The UK currently has one of the best road safety records in the EU and I believe that annual MOT tests play a role in this ranking. I urge you to review the government's stance on the MOT test and continue to prioritise road safety in the UK.
